The University of Nairobi, School of Business, has partnered with Bonn Rhein-Sieg University (BRSU) and University of Cape Coast (UCC) in a four (4) year program on 'German-African University Partnership Platform for the Development of Entrepreneurs and Small/Medium Enterprises'.

This project has a student exchange as one of its programs, and we are this year selecting **two students to study at Bonn Rhein-Sieg University (BRSU)** in Germany during the Semester from April 2018 to July 2018. Travel and living expenses will largely be covered under the program but the student will be expected to cover part of the living expenses.

Already several Bcom students have successfully gone through the program in the last three years.

We are therefore inviting interested students to submit applications for consideration to the undersigned, not later than **13th October, 2017**. Please pay attention to the following selection criteria:

- Academic Performance
- Evidence of involvement in student leadership
- Involve in community services/awards
- Moral integrity and discipline
- Community service

Note that only students currently in Level 3 (third year) who have successfully completed Level 1 and 2 will be considered. Students taking Msc. Marketing and Msc. Entrepreneurship and Innovations Management may also apply to do part of their research project work in Germany provided one has completed part I of the course by the time of going to Germany.
